Brief Biography – 2016

A/Prof Timothy F Chen is nationally and internationally renowned for his research in medication review and strategies to reduce medication related harm. Tim has been a registered pharmacist for >25 years and completed his PhD in 2002. He is a passionate teacher and lectures across a range of therapeutic areas. Tim is an experienced academic having supervised 22 postgraduate and 31 honours candidates to completion. He leads a large and productive research group at The University of Sydney, currently including eight PhD students. With his team, Tim has published more than 115 peer reviewed papers (Google Scholar H-Index 32, Scopus H-Index 25) in pharmacy, pharmacology and psychiatry journals, authored three practice-based books and received competitive research funds of > \$2 million. Tim currently serves as a member of the Board of Pharmaceutical Practice, International Federation of Pharmacists (FIP), having been elected President, Social and Administrative Section of FIP (2014-2018). He is an Associate Editor for BMC Medical Education and a member of the editorial boards for International Journal of Clinical Pharmacy and International Journal of Pharmacy Practice. Tim has served on numerous national advisory boards and scientific committees.
